Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

1. Hunter championships will be awarded in accordance with USEF Rules.
2. Stabling: All stalls will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis. The cost is \$200.00 per Stall and MUST be reserved by September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Stabling is temporary and includes doors/gates. Exhibitors may arrive no earlier than 12:00 PM on Wednesday, Sept. 24. ALL STABLING MUST BE PAID IN ADVANCE. NO EXCEPTIONS. NO REFUNDS.
3. Prize money not applied to the exhibitors balance due will be mailed to the owner, as listed on the entry form within 20 days of the completion of the show.
4. Warm-Up sessions will be held at the discretion of management.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted. Management also reserves the right to vary the officials, including the judges, if necessary; and to change or vary the courses at their discretion.
6. Scratches will be accepted only with a veterinarian's or medical certificate one hour before classes begin. No other scratches will be allowed except at the discretion of management. All scratches will be assessed a scratch fee of \$35 as well as a processing fee of \$30.00. There will be absolutely no refunds on stalls.
7. All entry blanks must be signed by the owner, trainer and rider (and parent/guardian when applicable) prior to numbers being assigned.
8. Order of Go for all finals classes will be posted and strictly followed.
9. During the judging, no one other than the rider(s) is(are) allowed in the ring except on official business.
10. If necessary, the management reserves the right to limit entries in classes due to time constraints. Entries will be allowed in such cases on a first come, first served basis. Management reserves the right to adjust the time schedule when necessary.
11. Exhibitors must be in proper attire for all classes.
12. Exhibitors are notified that any discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials by any owner, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees.
13. A fee of \$75.00 will be charge for each non-negotiable check. All checks must be payable in U.S. Dollars.
14. All dogs must be leashed at all times.
15. All exhibitors in the Amateur sections of this show must present their Amateur Certification card before numbers are issued.

16. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the Show Committee but the Grand Fall Classic Committee or the Westbrook Hunt Club will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Westbrook Hunt Club as well as the Show Committee harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any question or dispute arise, it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
17. Measurement Cards: All exhibitors in the Junior/Pony Hunter sections must present their measurement cards to the Secretary before numbers are issued. All Junior/Pony Hunters that do not have current measurement cards will be measured. Time and place of measurement stations will be announced.
18. A \$20.00 non-member fee will be charged in accordance with USEF/USHJA rules per association. Exhibitors who are members but do not present a current membership card (or copy) to the Secretary, must complete and sign an affidavit, and pay a \$5.00 fee. Non-member entrants who sign affidavits may be fined \$200.00 by USEF.
19. Post Entries: Shall be accepted up to one hour before the class at regular cost plus a late charge of \$25.00. No post entries will be accepted when such entry would require the dividing or redividing of a class or section.
20. Facility Fee Shall be \$35.00 for all hunter and equitation horses with the exception of leadline, walk-trot, and short-stirrup competitors. There will be a ticketed warm-up prior to the short-stirrup division for \$15. Schooling sessions are included and will be available everyday. Non-competing horses shall be charged a fee of \$50.00 in addition to the facility fee. All horses shall be assessed a processing fee of \$30.00.
21. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA Rules. To show in CHJA Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHJA annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at [www.chja.net](http://www.chja.net).
22. Stall Reservations and entries close September 10, 2008; Maclay entries close August 31<sup>th</sup> and must be made directly with the National Horse Show

**Pre Children's Equitation Division (CHJA)** Open to Junior riders who are eligible for limit equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current show year and have never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. Riders may show horses or ponies. Fence height 2'0". At the same show, riders may not cross enter into children's equitation, children's pony hunter, pony hunters any medal class over 2" or any class where fences exceed 2'6". No combinations permitted

22. **CHJA Children's Medal** Open to Junior members of the CHJA who are eligible for Children's Hunter, have not shown over a course where fences exceeded 3' at a Recognized show, and have never shown in the CHJA Junior Medal Finals. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 2'6" in height, which must contain two changes of direction after the first fence with no combinations permitted. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-8. Entry Fee \$35

222. **FW PHA Children's Medal** The contestant must be a junior rider who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current show year. Fences 2'6". Entry Fee \$35

23. **THIS / FW PHA Children's Medal** To be shown over a minimum of eight fences 2'9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. No water obstacles. The top four riders or 20% of the first round, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual test from USEF Tests 1-19. Entry Fee \$40

24. **CHJA Pony Medal** The contestant must be a junior member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current show year. The course will be not less than six fences: large ponies to jump 2'9", medium 2'3", and small ponies 2'0". All distances for combinations must be in accordance with current USEF rules. The judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot and canter. The same pony shall be shown by the same rider in all phases. To fill a class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. The flat phase shall count 50%. Judges may require additional USEF current tests 1-8. Entry Fee \$35

224. **Marshall & Sterling Pony Medal** - Entry fee \$35

25. **USEF Small Pony Medal** Open to junior members of USEF on ponies 14.2 hands and under. Riders entered in this class cannot cross enter into a USEF Medal Class at the same show. To be shown over a course of not less than six obstacles at 2'3" for small ponies. Two tests (1-9) are required during the first round. Entry Fee \$40

26. **USEF Medium Pony Medal** Same specs as class 25. Fences 2'6". Entry Fee \$40

27. **USEF Large Pony Medal** Same specs as class 25. Fences 3'. Entry Fee \$40

28. **CHJA Junior Medal** The contestant must be a junior member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current show year. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer and two changes of direction after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants to show at a walk, trot and canter. The flat phase is mandatory and shall count 50%. The same horse must be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. USEF Tests 1-19 may be required by the judges. Entry Fee \$35

29. **NEHC Medal** Contestants are required to be current junior members of NEHC who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current show year. However, contestants may join the NEHC at this show prior to the start of this class. One will qualify for the finals. Contestants shall perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judges discretion. USEF current Tests 1-19. To fill a class at least four competitors must complete the course. Entry Fee \$35

**30. USEF Hunt Seat Medal** Entry Fee \$40

**31. NHSAA ASPCA Horsemanship Class** For Junior riders who are junior patrons of the ASPCA and must show their ASPCA number on the entry blank. To fill a class at least 6 competitors must complete the course. Entry Fee \$40

**32. Washington International Hunter Phase** A qualifying event for the 2008 Washington International Horse Show Equitation Classic. Open to junior riders. To be judged under the Open Numerical Scoring System. Entry Fee \$40

**33. National PHA Medal** Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current show year. To be shown over a course of eight or more fences, 3'6" in height, with at least one combination and two changes of lead after the first fence. The judge will insert two tests into the original course (USEF Tests 1-18). Further testing of the top riders is optional. Only one rider per horse. To fill a class, six competitors must complete the course. Points will count 7-5-4-3-2-1 for classes with up to 29 riders; double points for 30-49 riders; triple points for 50 or more riders. Based on these points, their will be a ride-off among the top riders who have accumulated the most points throughout the year. The season begins September 1 and ends August 1. Winner of the ride-off is not eligible to compete after August 31st. Entry Fee \$40

**34. CHJA Adult Medal** Open to Amateur Adult members of CHJA. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height which must include one combination including an oxer and two changes of direction after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse must be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing using current USEF Tests 1-19. Entry Fee \$35

**35. NEHC Adult Amateur Medal** Open to adult amateur members of NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Current Tests 1-19) To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. Entry Fee \$35

**36. USEF Adult Equitation Medal** Open to amateur senior members of the USEF. To be shown over a course of at least eight obstacles at 3'3". The course must include one combination which includes an oxer and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required (USEF Current tests 1-19). To fill a class, six competitors must complete the course. Winner will receive a certificate from USA Equestrian. Entry Fee \$40

**37. Ariat / FW PHA National Adult Medal** To be shown over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'. At least two changes of direction, a combination, no water. Open Numerical Scoring in 1st round. Top four or 20% of riders from 1st round will be required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF current tests 1-19. Entry Fee \$40

**38. Regional Junior Medal Final** Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday and have qualified to ride in any Junior Medal Final. Jumps not to exceed 3'3". course to consist of a minimum 12 jumps. Open numerical scoring to be used in the first round. The top 10% of riders will return for the 2nd round. Additional tests of the top 4 riders will be optional. Entry Fee \$75

**39. Zone I Medal Final** Open to Zone 1 junior members of USEF who have not reached their 18th birthday.
