I agree to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of the US Equestrian and of this competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the US Equestrian, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the US Equestrian and/or this competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during this course of competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport or the US Equestrian. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of US Equestrian rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, any action instituted against the USA Equestrian must be filed in New York State. See Art. 1502.5.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF (CHJA, NEHC or CHSA) RULE BOOK AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

1. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA rules. To show in CHJA Medal Classes, riders must be members. In order to compete for CHJA Annual Year End Awards, the owner of the horse/pony must be a member of CHJA and the horse/pony must be registered with CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, Medal Class specifications and membership applications are available at the Show Secretary's office and at [www.chja.net](http://www.chja.net).
2. In order to compete for CHSA Annual Horse Awards, the person registering the horse must be an individual Member or Honorary Member and the horse must be registered with CHSA. Points shall accrue upon receipt of application and dues by the Show secretary at a member show, or the postmark date of an application and dues sent to the membership chair person.
3. Prize money will be awarded at the Secretary's office following the completion of the division. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to collect prize monies.
4. Show Management reserves the right to change or vary the courses at their discretion.
5. Warm-Up Classes will be held at the discretion of Show Management, time permitting, at a fee specified in the class descriptions. Schooling before the start of show will be from 7:00-7:45 AM.
6. Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted.
7. All entry blanks must be signed by the owner, trainer, rider, or parent/guardian (when applicable) prior to numbers being assigned.
8. Scratches will be accepted with veterinarians' certificate. Other scratches will be allowed at Show Management discretion. No refunds will be given.
9. During judging no one other than the rider is allowed in the ring unless on official business.
10. Proper attire required for all exhibitors.
11. Exhibitors are notified that any discourteous behavior or disobedience by any owner, groom, or rider shall disqualify horse and entry fees will be forfeited.
12. A processing fee for all returned checks of \$50.00 will be charged.
13. No dogs allowed.
14. Every animal entered for competition shall be under control of the Show Management. Westbrook Hunt Club will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold Windcrest Farm as well as Show Management harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any questions or disputes arise, it shall be referred Show Management whose decision is final.
15. All exhibitors must show current certification cards before numbers are issued.
16. Martingales prohibited in all flat or under saddle classes.
17. Hard Hats must be worn by anyone mounted on the premises.
18. Entry fees Regular Classes \$25.00; Medal Classes \$35.00 unless otherwise stated; Warm Up \$15
19. Trophy and Eight ribbons awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
20. Post Entry fee \$20.00 per horse.
21. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

22. If necessary, Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in classes due to time constraints. Entries will be allowed in such cases on a first come first serve basis. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the time schedule if necessary.

23. All classes in rated hunter divisions shall be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

Temporary Stalls will be available and must be paid for separately at time of stall reservation. The cost is \$150 per stall.

**WARM UP (\$15.00 (5 Horses/5 min.)**

### **PLEASURE CLASSES (CHSA/NEHC 'C')**

Entry Fee for Pleasure Classes is \$25.

### **HUNTER PLEASURE (NEHC/CHSA 'C')**

Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes, with no limitations as to status of rider. Walk, Trot, Canter both ways. Light contact required. Judged on manners, performance, quality, presence substance and soundness.

110. CHSA Pleasure

### **HUNT SEAT EQUITATION CLASSES (CHJA/CHSA/NEHC/USEF)**

Entry fee for Hunt Seat Equitation classes is \$25.00. A trophy and eight ribbons will be awarded in each class.

### **CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION (CHJA, CHSA, MHJ, NEHC 'C')**

Open to riders who are eligible for Children's Hunter, have not shown over a course where fences exceeded 3' at a Recognized show, and have never shown in the CHJA Junior Medal Finals. No combinations. Fences for horses and large ponies 2'6", for small/medium ponies 2'0".

### **OPEN EQUITATION (CHJA, CHSA, NEHC 'C')**

Open to riders under the age of 18, have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 2'9" at a recognized show.

37. Open Equitation Under 18 over Fences fences not to exceed 2'9"

### **SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION (CHJA/CHSA/NEHC 'C', MHJ)**

Open to riders 12 years and under who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show. Riders showing in this division may not compete in any other recognized division or recognized class in a show with fences exceeding 18" with the exception of pleasure and pet-type pony classes.

## MEDAL CLASSES

### \$35 Fee for all Medal Classes

**69. CHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL** Open to Junior members of the CHJA who are eligible for Children's Hunter, have not shown over a course where fences exceeded 3' at a Recognized show. If you have ever qualified or shown in a 3' Equitation Finals including CHJA, you are not eligible for the Children's Medal. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 2'6" in height, which must contain two changes of direction after the first fence with no combinations permitted. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-8.

**70. CHJA PONY MEDAL** Rider to be a Junior Member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than six obstacles. Small ponies to jump obstacles 2'0" in height, Medium ponies to jump obstacles 2'3" in height, and Large ponies to jump obstacles 2'9" in height. If a combination is used, suggested distances for in and outs are 20' for small, 22' for medium, and 24' for large ponies. If the distance between obstacles is less than 72' then the distance must be adjusted for each height section. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same pony to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-8.

**57. CHJA ADULT MEDAL:** Rider to be an Amateur Adult Member of the CHJA. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-19.

### **38. CHJA JUNIOR MEDAL**

Rider to be a Junior Member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-19.

### **58. NEHC ADULT MEDAL**

Open to Adult Amateur Members of the NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-19) To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win

required for the finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for Medal classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

**68. CHSA Children's Medal:** Open to Junior riders who have not shown over fences exceeding 3' in a recognized show. Horses or ponies, 2'6", no combinations. At least two tests from USEF 1-8 to be included. To fill the class at least 3 contestants must complete the class. It is not necessary to be a CHSA member, but only members will accrue points toward Finals. The other medal class to include is the CHSA Short Stirrup Medal. This is not included in the time schedule, but could be inserted and numbered # 103m. (so as not to upset the numbering system) and insert it in the Time Schedule after class 3 103. The specs are:

**104. CHSA Short Stirrup Medal:** Open to riders 12 and under who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show. Fences not to exceed 18", no combinations. At least two tests from USEF 1-8 to be included. To fill the class at least 3 contestants must complete the class. It is not necessary to be a CHSA member, but only members will accrue points toward Finals.

### **39. NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL**

Open to Junior Members of the NEHC who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-18). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required for the finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for Medal classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

### **59. ARIAT ADULT MEDAL**

To be shown over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'. At least two changes of direction, a combination, no water. Open numerical scoring in 1<sup>st</sup> round. Top 4 or 20% of riders from 1<sup>st</sup> round will be required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF current tests 1-19.

### **59. M&S ADULT MEDAL**

Open to Adult and Amateur Riders. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals.

### **59. FWPHA ADULT MEDAL**

Open to adult amateur riders. Testing on a flat phase of the top four riders, if available, or mgmt may opt to incorporate the test into the course. Class may be run in conjunction with another recognized class with the same specs. Fence height 2'6".

### **76. FWPHA CHILDREN'S MEDAL**

Open to all junior riders. Testing on a flat phase of the top four riders if available is required, or mgmt may incorporate a test into the course. Class may be run in conjunction with another recognized class with the same specs. Fence height 2'6".

### **40. PHA MEDAL**

The National PHA Medal Hunter Seat Equitation Class is open to riders under 18 years of age. To be shown over a course of eight or more fences at 3'6" in height, with at least one combination including an oxer and two changes of lead after the first fence. The judge will insert two tests into the original course (USEF Tests 1-18). Further testing of the top riders is optional. Only one rider per horse. To fill a class, six competitors must complete the course.

### **76. T.H.I.S. NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MEDAL (Capital Challenge)**

Open to all Junior members of the USEF and CEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6" (i.e.; Pessoa/USEF Medal; ASPCA Maclay; USET; CET or CEF Finals; WIHS Capital Cup).
