I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the US Equestrian, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the US Equestrian and/or this competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during this course of competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport or the US Equestrian. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. RULES AND REGULATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF (CHJA, NEHC or CHSA) RULE BOOK. AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

1. **PRIZE MONEY** will be applied against outstanding entry fees, remaining balance will be mailed to the owner of record withing 20 days of the completion of the show.
2. Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes as it sees warranted, and in accordance with USEF rules regarding same.
3. A facilities fee of \$30 will be charged to all entries except Breeding.
4. **POST ENTRIES** will be accepted at \$30 per horse, only if time permits..
5. Non- competing horses charged \$50.
6. All entry blanks must be signed by the owner. trainer, rider, or parent/guardian (when applicable) prior to numbers being assigned.
7. Scratches will be accepted with veterinarians' certificate. Scratches will be charged a fee of \$30 in addition to the office fee.
8. A processing fee for all returned checks of \$50.00 will be charged.
9. All dogs must be leashed. Loose dog fine \$200 plus all fees of horse on course if caught in the show ring.
10. Every animal entered for competition shall be under control of the Show Management. Westbrook Hunt Club will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold Westbrook Hunt Clubas well as Show Management harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any questions or disputes arise, it shall be referred Show Management whose decision is final.
11. Martingales prohibited in all flat or under saddle classes.
12. Hard Hats must be worn by anyone mounted on the premises.
13. If necessary, Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in classes due to time constraints. Entries will be allowed in such cases on a first come first serve basis. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the time schedule if necessary.
14. All classes in rated hunter divisions shall be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. In A rated divisions one class will be judged on conformation.
15. **STALL RESERVATIONS** close April 19th. Stall payments **MUST** accompany reservation. Stalls are 10x10 with doors.Stalls \$150. Stalls reserved after April 19th will be priced at \$200.

Jump orders will be established at the in-gate for all regular classes. Computer generated jump orders will be postes for all classics at least one one hour prior to the start of the class. Nomination Fee is \$50; nominated divisions will have an add back of \$10 per entry & \$100 purse. Add back will awarded 35% 25% 15% 10% 8% 7%. Entry fee \$35 unless otherwise stated.

Motorized Vehicle Statement-

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
