## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF (CHJA, NEHC or CHSA) RULE BOOK. AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

1. In order to compete for annual awards in CHJA, NEHC & CHSA membership is required. Membership forms, rule books, and class specs are available at the Secretary's office and at [www.chja.net](http://www.chja.net), chsaonline.com and nehc.net.
2. Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes as it sees warranted, and in accordance with USEF rules regarding same.
3. Office fee of \$30 will be charged on all entries.
4. **POST ENTRIES** will be accepted at \$30 per horse, only if time permits..
5. Warm-Up Classes will be held at the discretion of Show Management.
6. Sharps Containers will be located at the end of the main barn & at both ends of new building.
7. All entry blanks must be signed by the owner, trainer, rider, or parent/guardian (when applicable) prior to numbers being assigned.
8. Scratches will be accepted with veterinarians' certificate. Scratches will be charged a fee of \$30 in addition to the office fee.
9. A processing fee for all returned checks of \$50.00 will be charged.
10. All dogs must be leashed.
11. Every animal entered for competition shall be under control of the Show Management. Westbrook Hunt Club will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold Westbrook Hunt Club as well as Show Management harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any questions or disputes arise, it shall be referred Show Management whose decision is final.
12. All exhibitors must show current certification cards before numbers are issued.
13. Martingales prohibited in all flat or under saddle classes.
14. Hard Hats must be worn by anyone mounted on the premises.
15. Entry fees Regular Classes \$25.00; Medal Classes \$35.00 unless otherwise stated; Warm Up \$15 Non competing horses will be charged \$50
16. Trophy or cash prize and Eight ribbons awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
17. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
18. If necessary, Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in classes due to time constraints. Entries will be allowed in such cases on a first come first serve basis. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the time schedule if necessary.
19. **Stall Reservations may be available by request.** Contact WHC for availability and pricing.
20. Measurements will be conducted each day at 9:00 AM.

## **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS**

All classes are run According to USEF Zone 1 Specifications and where applicable are run according to the rules and specifications of the CHJA, CHSA, NEHC and M&S. USEF Zone 1 Specifications will be posted in Secretary's Office.

### **EQUITATION CLASSES (CHJA/CHSA/NEHC)**

Entry fee for Hunt Seat Equitation classes is \$25.00. A trophy and eight ribbons will be awarded in each class.

#### **SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION (CHJA/CHSA/NEHC 'C')**

Open to riders 12 years and under who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show. Riders showing in this division may not compete in any other recognized division or recognized class in a show with fences exceeding 18" with the exception of pleasure and pet-type pony classes.

Short Stirrup Equitation 18" (MHJ Short Stirrup Medal Qualifier)

#### **PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION (CHJA/ CHSA)**

Open to junior riders who are eligible for Limit Equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current show year and have never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. Riders may show horses or ponies. Fence height 2'0". At the same show, riders may not cross enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Pony Hunter, Pony Hunters, any Medal classes that exceed 2' or any class where fences exceed 2'6". No combinations permitted.

6. Pre-Children's Equitation over fences

#### **CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION (CHJA/CHSA/NEHC 'C')**

Open to riders who are eligible for Children's Hunter, have not shown over a course where fences exceeded 3' at a Recognized show, and have never shown in the CHJA Junior Medal Finals. No combinations. Fences for horses and large ponies 2'6", for small/medium ponies 2'0".

7. Children's Equitation on the flat
8. Children's Equitation over fences
9. Children's Equitation over fences

#### **MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION (CHJA/CHSA/ NEHC 'C')**

Open to Amateur Adult riders who have not won six blue ribbons in recognized adult equitation classes or CHJA Adult Medal Classes, excluding Modified Adult Equitation. For Amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of Dec. 1 of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher at more than three recognized horse shows within the past two years. Riders may not show in any class where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show. Judge may request test 1-7. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

#### **AMATEUR ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION (CHJA/CHSA/NEHC 'C')**

Open to Adult Amateurs. Courses must contain at least six individual jumping efforts, with one change of lead and at least one combination. Fences 2'9" to 3'.

#### **JUNIOR EQUITATION DIVISION (CHJA/CHSA)**

Open to all junior riders. Riders cannot cross enter into the Children's Equitation Division at the same show. Fence height 3'0".

## MEDAL CLASSES

### \$35 Fee for Medal Classes unless otherwise stated

24. **FW/PHA CHILDREN'S MEDAL**  
Open to all junior riders. Testing or a flat phase of the top four riders if available is required, or mgmt may incorporate a test into the course. Class may be run in conjunction with another recognized class with the same specs. Fence height 2'6".
25. **CHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL** Open to Junior members of the CHJA who are eligible for Children's Hunter, have not shown over a course where fences exceeded 3' at a Recognized show. If you have ever qualified or shown in a 3' Equitation Finals including CHJA, you are not eligible for the Children's Medal. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 2'6" in height, which must contain two changes of direction after the first fence with no combinations permitted. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-8.
26. **CHSA CHILDREN'S MEDAL**  
Open to members and non-members but only CHSA members will accrue points. A minimum of three must finish the class, at least one must be a member of CHSA. Each class must have two tests included (USEF 1-8)
27. **CHSA CHILDREN'S SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL**  
Open to members and non-members but only CHSA members will accrue points. A minimum of three must finish the class, at least one must be a member of CHSA. Each class must have two tests included (USEF 1-8)
28. **CHSA PRE-CHILDREN'S MEDAL**  
Open to members and non-members but only CHSA members will accrue points. A minimum of three must finish the class, at least one must be a member of CHSA. Each class must have two tests included (USEF 1-8)
29. **CHSA MODIFIED ADULT MEDAL**  
Open to members and non-members but only CHSA members will accrue points. A minimum of three must finish the class, at least one must be a member of CHSA. Each class must have two tests included (USEF 1-8)
31. **CHJA ADULT MEDAL:**  
Rider to be an Amateur Adult Member of the CHJA. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-19.
32. **NEHC ADULT MEDAL**  
Open to Adult Members of the NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'0". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-18). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required for the finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for Medal classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.
33. **ARIAT/FWPHA/M&S ADULT MEDAL \$40 for class**  
**ARIAT ADULT MEDAL**  
To be shown over at least eight fences not to exceed 3'. At least two changes of direction, a combination, no water. Open numerical scoring in 1<sup>st</sup> round. Top 4 or 20% of riders from 1<sup>st</sup> round will be required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF current tests 1-19.  
**M&S ADULT MEDAL**  
Open to Adult and Amateur Riders. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals.

### FW-PHA ADULT MEDAL

Open to adult amateur riders. Testing or a flat phase of the top four riders, if available, or mgmt may opt to incorporate the test into the course. Class may be run in conjunction with another recognized class with the same specs. Fence height 3'0".

### 34. THIS/FWPHA/M&S MEDAL \$40 for class

#### T.H.I.S. NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MEDAL (Capital Challenge)

Open to all Junior members of the USEF and CEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6" (i.e.; Pessoa/USEF Medal; ASPCA Maclay; USET; CET or CEF Finals; WIHS Capital Cup). To be shown over a minimum of eight fences 2'9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top four riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1-19. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round.

There is no minimum requirement to fill the class.

#### FW/PHA CHILDREN'S MEDAL

Open to Junior riders. Testing or a flat phase of the top four riders, if available, or mgmt may opt to incorporate the test into the course. Class may be run in conjunction with another recognized class with the same specs. Fence height 3'0".

#### MARSHALL & STERLING

Open to Junior Riders on horses who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. Fence height 3'.

### 35. CHJA JUNIOR MEDAL

Rider to be a Junior Member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-19.

36. **NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL** Open to Members of the NEHC who have not yet reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'0". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-18). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required for the finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for Medal classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

### 37. National/ FW- PHA MEDAL

The National PHA Medal Hunter Seat Equitation Class is open to riders under 18 years of age. To be shown over a course of eight or more fences at 3'6" in height, with at least one combination including an oxer and two changes of lead after the first fence. The judge will insert two tests into the original course (USEF Tests 1-18). Further testing of the top riders is optional. Only one rider per horse. To fill a class, six competitors must complete the course.

### 38. PESSOA/USEF NATIONAL HUNT SEAT MEDAL

OPEN TO JUNIOR MEMBERS OF USEF WHO HAVE NOT YET REACHED THEIR 18<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY.

**39. ASPCA MACLAY**

For junior riders who are junior patrons of the ASPCA and must show their ASPCA numbers on the entry blank. To fill the class at least 6 competitors must complete the course.

**41. PLATINUM PERFORMANCE USEF TALENT SEARCH** USEF Show Jumping Talent Search Class. A test of the abilities of an individual as a show jumping rider, is open to Junior/Young Riders who are members of the United States Equestrian Federation who have not reached their 21st birthday under USEF rules. Fences 3'6"-3'9".

**42. MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S PONY MEDAL**

**57. CHJA PONY MEDAL**

Rider to be a Junior Member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than six obstacles. Small ponies to jump obstacles 2' in height, Medium ponies to jump 2'3" in height, and Large ponies to jump 2'9" in height. If a combination is used, suggested distances for in and out are 20' for small, 22' for medium, and 24' for large ponies. If the distance between obstacles is less than 72' then the distance must be adjusted for each height section. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same pony to be shown by the same rider in both phases. Judges may require additional testing. USEF Tests 1-8.

Height of fences 3' for horses, small & medium ponies 2'; large ponies 2'6"; spreads not to exceed fence height. The division may be split at the discretion of show management. Same horse/pony rider combination cannot show in any other rated division except Equitation or pleasure. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or section at the same show except Jr. Hunter. Ponies may not cross enter into the regular pony hunter division. Riders may not show in any class where the fence heights exceed 3'6" at the same show. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge.

## **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nation who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
