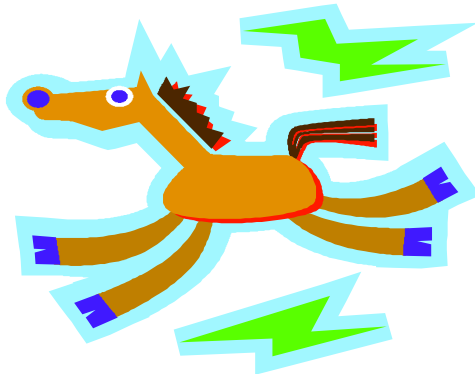

**Federation Entry Agreement Effective 12/1/09**

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

**USEF Membership Statement**

Life, senior active and Junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory are classes level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF (CHJA, NEHC or CHSA) RULE BOOK. AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

1. CHJA: Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA rules. To show in CHJA Medal Classes, riders must be members. In order to compete for CHJA Annual Year End Awards, the owner of the horse/pony must be a member of CHJA and the horse/pony must be registered with CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, Medal Class specifications and membership applications are available at the Show Secretary's office and at [www.chja.net](http://www.chja.net).
2. CHSA: In order to compete for CHSA Annual Horse Awards, the person registering the horse must be an individual Member or Honorary Member and the horse must be registered with CHSA. Points shall accrue upon receipt of application and dues by the Show secretary at a member show, or the postmark date of an application and dues sent to the membership chair person.
3. Prize money will be awarded in coordination with your entries from the Secretary's office following the completion of the division. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to collect prize monies. Updates/changes/corrections will be posted in the Show Office.
4. Show Management reserves the right to change or vary the courses at their discretion.
5. Schooling will be available before the start of show and/or as designated.
6. Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted.
7. All entry blanks must be signed by the owner, trainer, rider, and/or parent/guardian (when applicable) prior to numbers being assigned.
8. Scratches will be accepted with veterinarians' certificate; other scratches will be allowed/disallowed at Show Management's discretion. No refunds on stalls or entries will be given.
9. During judging, unless on official business, no one other than the rider/handler is allowed in the ring.
10. Proper attire is required for all exhibitors.
11. Exhibitors are notified that any discourteous behavior or disobedience by any owner, groom, or rider shall disqualify horse and entry fees will be forfeited.
12. A processing fee of \$100 will be charged for all returned checks.
13. All dogs must be leashed at all times.
14. Every animal entered for competition shall be under control of the Show Management. Westbrook Hunt Club will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold WHC as well as Show Management harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any questions or disputes arise, it shall be referred Show Management whose decision is final.
15. All exhibitors must show current certification cards before numbers are issued.
16. Martingales prohibited in all flat or under saddle classes.
17. ASTM approved headgear must be worn by anyone mounted on the premises.
18. Entry fees: Regular Classes \$25.00; Medal Classes and Hunter Classics \$35.00 unless otherwise stated; Warm Up \$20/trip.
19. Trophy and eight ribbons awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
20. ENTRIES CLOSE ON JUNE 24. Post-entries will be accepted, as time permits at \$25/horse.
21. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on

competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an Adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

22. If necessary, Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in classes due to time constraints. Entries will be allowed in such cases on a first come first serve basis. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the time schedule if necessary.

23. All classes in rated hunter divisions shall be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

24. Show Management may fine individuals up to \$100 for improper needles/sharps disposals.

25. A limited number of temporary, canvas stabling, 10X10 stalls with doors will be available as follows: \$175.00/one show; \$300/two shows; \$375/three shows. STALL REQUESTS CLOSE JUNE 23, 2011. Stalls reserved after that date will be based on availability and billed with a \$25 surcharge each.

26. Night Watch will be charged \$20 per stall with your entry fees. Coverage will be provided by New England Night Watch LLC.

27. Horses shown in a class without being entered will be billed \$30 in addition to the entry fee.

28. An office fee of \$30 will be charged to each entry.

29. A fee of \$50 will be charged for non-showing horses.

30. A facilities fee of \$30 will be charged to all entries with the exception of Pleasure, Walk Trot, Breeding and Leadline.

**CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:** All classes are run according to USEF Zone 1 Specifications, and where applicable, according to the rules and specifications of the applicable affiliate organization, i.e. CHJA, CHSA, M&S, NAL, NEHC. Champion and Reserve Champion as applicable.

Open to riders 12 and under who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show. Riders showing in this division may not compete in any other recognized division or recognized class in this show with fences exceeding 18" with the exception of pleasure and pet-type pony classes.

Open to Junior riders who are eligible for Limit Equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current show year and have never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. Riders may show horses or ponies. Fence height 2'0". At the same show, riders may not cross enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Pony Hunter, Pony Hunters, any Medal classes that exceed 2' or any class where fences exceed 2'6".

Open to Amateur Adult riders who have not won six blue ribbons in recognized Adult equitation classes or CHJA Adult Medal Classes, excluding Modified Adult Equitation. For Amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult, if as of Dec. 1 of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher at more than three USEF or CHJA recognized horse shows within the past two years. Riders may not show in any class where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

**MEDAL CLASSES \$35 Fee for Medal Classes unless otherwise stated.**

**CHJA MEDALS:** Open to members only. At least 4 riders must complete both the fence and flat phase and the same horse/pony must be used for both phases. The flat phase will count 50%. Members may compete in only one CHJA Medal Class per show.

**CHSA MEDALS:** Open to members and nonmembers, but only members will accrue points. At least 3 riders must complete the class; at least one must be a CHSA member. Two tests (USEF 1-8) will be included in each course. Riders may compete in only one CHSA Medal Class per show.

25. **CHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL** Junior members eligible for Children's Hunter, have not shown over a course where fences exceeded 3' at a Recognized show, and have not ever qualified or shown in a 3' Equitation Final. Fences at 2'6" in height; Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-8.
26. **CHSA CHILDREN'S MEDAL FENCES AT 2'6"**

33. **ARIAT/FARNUM ADULT MEDAL** Fences not to exceed 3'. Open numerical scoring in 1<sup>st</sup> rd. Entry fee \$40.
34. **T.H.I.S. /M&S CHILDREN'S MEDAL** Open to all Junior members of the USEF and CEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6". The top four riders are required to perform at least two individual tests. An Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider's score announced. There is no minimum requirement to fill the class. Entry fee \$40.
35. **CHJA JUNIOR MEDAL** Fences at 3'.
36. **Sections A/B - NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL** Open to Junior members of the NEHC; fences not to exceed 3'3".
38. **PESSOA/USEF NATIONAL HUNT SEAT MEDAL** Open to Junior members of the USEF. Entry fee is \$40.
39. **ASPCA MACLAY** For Junior patrons of the ASPCA and must show their ASPCA numbers on the entry blank. To fill the class at least 6 competitors must complete the course. Entry fee is \$40.

40. **M & S JUNIOR MEDAL** Open to Junior Riders; fences at 3'6". Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count.
41. **PLATINUM PERFORMANCE USEF TALENT SEARCH** USEF Show Jumping Talent Search Class. A test of the abilities of an individual as a show jumping rider, is open to Junior/Young Riders who are members of the United States Equestrian Federation who have not reached their 21st birthday under USEF rules. Fences 3'6"-3'9". Entry is \$40.
42. **WIHS EQUITATION CLASSIC** Open to Junior members of USEF. Three riders must complete the course for the class to be included in the National Ranking. Same horse must be used in all phases of the event. Only one rider per horse. Entry for each section is \$40.
  - A. **JUMPER PHASE** - To be shown over a minimum of 10 jumps at 1.10m (3'7").
  - B. **HUNTER PHASE**- To be shown over a minimum of 8 jumps at 3'6".
44. **EQUISPORT USEF PONY MEDAL** Open to Junior members of the USEF on ponies. Exhibitors entered in this class cannot enter the PESSOA USEF Medal class at the same show. Suitability of a pony will be emphasized. Entry fee is \$40.
45. **WIHS PONY MEDAL** to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles. Fence heights: 2'3" for ponies not exceeding 12.2 hands; 2'6" for ponies over 12.2 hands and not exceeding 13.2 hands; and 3' for ponies over 13.2 hands and not exceeding 14.2 hands. A maximum of 20 riders may be asked to return to show at the walk, trot and canter and to perform any additional tests at the judges' discretion.
46. **M & S CHILDREN'S MEDAL PONY** Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 2'6". Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Horse Medal at the same show. Fence height 2' for SM/MED; 2'6" for LARGE.
47. **CHJA PONY MEDAL** Small ponies to jump obstacles 2' in height, Medium ponies to jump 2'3" in height, and Large ponies to jump 2'9" in height. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%.

#### **PLEASURE CLASSES (CHSA/NEHC 'C')**

**PLEASURE** Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes, with no limitations as to status of rider. Walk, Trot, Canter both ways. Light contact required. Judged on manners, performance, quality, presence substance and soundness. It is not necessary to be a member of either organization to enter.

**CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION (CHJA/CHSA/NEHC "C")**

Open to Junior Exhibitors who are eligible for Intermediate Equitation Over Fences as of December 1 of the current show year. Height of fences 3' for horses, small & medium ponies 2'; large ponies 2'6"; spreads not to exceed fence height. The division may be split at the discretion of show management. Same horse/pony rider combination cannot show in any other rated division except Equitation or pleasure. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or section at the same show except Jr. Hunter. Ponies may not cross enter into the regular pony hunter division. Riders may not show in any class where the fence heights exceed 3'6" at the same show.

**ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER DIVISION (CHJA,CHSA, NEHC)**

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Horse/rider combinations are not eligible for any other USEF rated classes. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at judge's discretion.
