Federation Entry Agreement Effective 12/1/09

*By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur or on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, **broadcasts, internet, film, new media** or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.*

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory are classes level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF (CHJA, NEHC or CHSA) RULE BOOK AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

1. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA rules. To show in CHJA Medal Classes, riders must be members. In order to compete for CHJA Annual Year End Awards, the owner of the horse/pony must be a member of CHJA and the horse/pony must be registered with CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, Medal Class specifications and membership applications are available at the Show Secretary's office and at www.chja.net.
2. In order to compete for CHSA Annual Horse Awards, the person registering the horse must be an individual Member or Honorary Member and the horse must be registered with CHSA. Points shall accrue upon receipt of application and dues by the Show secretary at a member show, or the postmark date of an application and dues sent to the membership chair person.
3. Prize money will be awarded at the Secretary's office following the completion of the division. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to collect prize monies.
4. Show Management reserves the right to change or vary the courses at their discretion.
5. Schooling will be available before the start of show from 7:00-7:45 AM.
6. Show Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted.
7. All entry blanks must be signed by the owner, trainer, rider, and/or parent/guardian (when applicable) prior to numbers being assigned.
8. Scratches will be accepted with veterinarians' certificate; other scratches will be allowed/disallowed at Show Management's discretion. No refunds will be given.
9. During judging, unless on official business, no one other than the rider is allowed in the ring.
10. Proper attire required for all exhibitors.
11. Exhibitors are notified that any discourteous behavior or disobedience by any owner, groom, or rider shall disqualify horse and entry fees will be forfeited.
12. A processing fee of \$50 will be charged for all returned checks.
13. All dogs must be leashed at all times or the owner will be fined \$100.
14. Every animal entered for competition shall be under control of the Show Management. Westbrook Hunt Club will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold WHC as well as Show Management harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any questions or disputes arise, it shall be referred Show Management whose decision is final.
15. All exhibitors must show current certification cards before numbers are issued.
16. Martingales prohibited in all flat or under saddle classes.
17. Hard Hats must be worn by anyone mounted on the premises.
18. Entry fees: Regular Classes \$25.00; Medal Classes \$35.00 unless otherwise stated; Blue/Red \$20/trip; classic \$40.
19. Trophy and eight ribbons awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
20. Entries close at 5pm the night before; after that time they are subject to post entry fee of \$30.
21. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a part or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainers from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
22. If necessary, Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in classes due to time constraints. Entries will be allowed in such cases on a first come first serve basis. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the time schedule if necessary.
23. All classes in rated hunter divisions shall be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
24. Show Management may fine individuals up to \$100 for improper needles/sharps disposals.
25. A limited number of 10X10 stalls w/ doors are available prepaid for \$150.00. Night watch available.

All classes are run according to USEF Zone 1 Specifications, and where applicable, are run according to the rules and specifications of the applicable affiliate organization, i.e. CHJA, CHSA, M&S, NAL, PHA and NEHC. Eight ribbons for each class. Division Champion and Reserve Champion Awarded.

CHSA MEDALS: Open to members and nonmembers, but only members accrue points.

At least 3 riders must complete the class; at least one must be a CHSA member. Two tests (USEF 1-8) will be included in each course. Riders may compete in only one CHSA Medal class per show.

3. CHSA SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION MEDAL: Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Fence height 18".

4. CHSA PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION MEDAL: Fences 2'.

5. CHSA CHILDREN'S EQUITATION MEDAL: Fences 2'6".

6. CHSA MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION MEDAL: Fence height 2'6".

CHJA MEDALS: Open to members only. At least 4 riders must complete the both the flat and fence phase. The flat phase to count 50%. The same horse/pony and rider in both phases. Members may compete in only one CHJA Medal class per show.

7. CHJA JUNIOR MEDAL: Fences at 3'; optional current USEF Tests 1-19.

8. CHJA ADULT MEDAL: Fences at 3'; optional current USEF Tests 1-19.

9. CHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL: Juniors eligible for Children's Hunter and haven't jumped over 3' at recognized shows and never qualified or show in a 3' equitation Final, including CHJA. Fences at 2'6"; optional current USEF Tests 1-8.

10. CHJA PONY MEDAL: Fences at 2', 2'3", 2'6". Optional current USEF Tests 1-8.

11. WIHS PONY MEDAL Open to Junior member of the WIHS.

12. ASPCA MACLAY Open to Junior Members of the ASPCA. At least 6 competitors must complete the course. Fences at 3'6".

13. MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S MEDAL PONY Open to Junior Riders on ponies who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Horse Medal at the same show. Fence Height 2' for Sm/Med, 2'6" for Lg).

14. MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S MEDAL HORSE Open to Junior Riders on horses who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. Three riders must complete the course. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. Fences at 3'.

15. PESSOA/USEF HUNT SEAT MEDAL Open to Junior Members of the USEF. Two or more tests of at least the top four competitors are required. Tests 1-19.

16. T.H.I.S. NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MEDAL Open to all Junior members of the USEF and CEF who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6". The top four riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF Tests 1-19. There is no minimum requirement to fill the class.

17. PHA MEDAL Open to junior riders. Fence height 3'6". The judge will insert two tests into the original course, USEF tests 1-18), At least three entrants must complete the course.

18. NEHC ADULT MEDAL Open to Adult Amateur Members of the NEHC. Optional USEF Tests 1-19. At least four competitors must complete the course. Fences 2'9"-3'.

19. NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL Open to Junior Members of the NEHC; Fences not to exceed 3'3". Optional USEF Tests 1-18. At least four competitors must complete the course.

20. ARIAT ADULT MEDAL Open to Adult Amateurs. Fences not to exceed 3'. 20% of riders from 1st round will be required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF current tests 1-19.

21. M&S ADULT MEDAL Open to Adult Amateurs. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. Three riders must complete the course. Fences at 3'.

22. EQUISPORT INSURANCE /USEF PONY MEDAL Open to Junior members of the USEF. Exhibitors entered in this class cannot enter the USEF Medal class at the same show. Suitability of pony will be emphasized.

23. PLATINUM PERFORMANCE/USEF SHOW JUMPING TALENT SEARCH Open to Junior/Young Riders who are members of the United States Equestrian Federation who have not reached their 21st birthday under USEF rules. Fences 3'7"-3'9".

24. MARSHALL & STERLING JUNIOR MEDAL: Fences at 3'6". Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count.
